Both examinations

10 common items on basic economic principles and current economic issues.

Year 11 (and Year 10)

20 items covering all three topics in Unit 1 Markets and models, including 3-5 on market failure.

Year 12

20 items covering all Unit 3, including Unit 4 topic 1 Macroeconomic objectives and theory. No questions on Unit 4 Topic 2.
